Financial Report and Approval of Payments:

Ms. Roman guided the Board through the review of finances as of July 31, 2020. The balance sheet, cash as of 7/31/2020 was \$1,545,047 this includes a total of \$657,698 in CDs to the lines of credit. DLP Investment was \$270,786. The current month school year fund balance is \$2,834,837 Accounts payable as of 7/31/2020 are \$19,965 with estimated bills of \$310,156 for payroll accrual and PSERS liability. For the one months ending 7/31/2020 the school had a surplus of \$141,621 compared to a planned surplus of \$144,506 resulting in a unfavorable variance of (\$2,886.)

Ms. Roman called for a motion to approve the fiscal year financial report ending July 31, 2020 and for the list of bills to be paid. Motion was made by Mr. Santana seconded by Mr. Lopez. Motion was passed unanimously.

Old Business

• Traverser Wall – The wall was finally installed and it's ready for when students are able to use it. Mr. Fedorczyk expressed his gratitude to Ms. Pluchinsky to the Board.

• LVDLCS By Laws – Article II – Membership – Second Reading - It read "The LVDLCS shall be governed by a Board of Trustees composed of nine members." It needs to change to - "The LVDLCS shall be governed by a Board of Trustees composed of 5 to 9 members."

Mr. Lopez called for a motion to approve the revision to the LVDLCS By-Laws as presented. Motion was seconded by Dr. Rance-Roney. Motion was approved unanimously.

• PCCD 20-21 School Safety and Health Funding –Virtual Summer School – The school was granted the \$90,000.

New Business

• **10-Month Employee Contracts** – The contracts were signed by the Board for the 10-Month employees from August 10, 2020 to June 30, 2021.

Mr. Lopez called for a motion for the approval of the 10-month employee contracts. Motion was seconded by Ms. Siderias. Motion was approved unanimously.

- End of Summer School Report A report was presented to the Board with actual cost of the virtual summer program totaling \$11,040 in payroll (without taxes.) The proposed budget for the virtual summer school program was \$53,662 including materials not used and estimated taxes.
- LVDLCS Emergency Instructional Time Template A local education agency (LEA) that elects to implement temporary provisions in response to the COVID-19 global pandemic may meet the minimum 180 days of instruction and 900 hours of instruction at the elementary level and 990 hours of instruction at the secondary level through a combination of face-to-face and remote instruction.

Mr. Lopez called for a motion to approve the LVDLCS Emergency Instructional Time Template as presented. Motion was seconded by Mr. Santana. Motion was approved unanimously.

• Logitech Connect Cameras – The cameras will be used to teach students virtually. These cameras were recommended by the IU. They were purchased as soon as possible to be able to test them to give to the instruction staff before the start of the school year. The cameras offer superior video and audio with a compact 3-inch footprint, works with meeting and video conferencing applications and has plugfree mobility with rechargeable battery. The cameras were previously presented to the Board; however approval is needed for the purchase of 22 cameras totaling \$11,961.78.

Dr. Rance-Roney called for a motion to approve the purchase of the Logitech Connect Cameras as presented. Motion was seconded by Ms. Siderias. Motion was approved unanimously.

• **Air Purifiers** – *Not an agenda item, added to meeting* – The school purchased air purifiers for all classrooms and offices. The total cost of 33 air purifiers was \$11,056.88 and needs retroactive approval from the Board.

Dr. Rance-Roney called for a motion to approve the purchase of the air purifiers as presented. Motion was seconded by Mr. Lopez. Motion was approved unanimously.

Adjournment – A motion to adjourn was made by Mr. Lopez seconded by Ms. Siderias. There were no questions or comments. Motion was approved unanimously. Meeting was adjourned at 6:52 p.m.

- New MBI Contract The school is currently in negotiations with MBI as their contract price increased and the school is trying to understand the reason why. The Board was informed of the questions being discussed with MBI and we are waiting on the responses. The Board will be informed.
- Lease Reimbursement Authorization to Apply (PDE 418) The application for lease reimbursement needs approval from the Board to be submitted. The lease reimbursement will be submitted electronically.

Mr. Lopez called for a motion to permit Repice & Taylor to apply for the Lease Reimbursement (PDE 418) on behalf of LVDLCS Motion was seconded by Mr. Santana. Motion was approved unanimously.

- Linton Breakfast & Lunch Program The Breakfast and Lunch program needs to be available to families even if they are not physically in the school by offering parents the opportunity to come to the school to pick up the food. The food can be sent home up to a week at a time if they need it. They will not be able to just go to their nearest school; they need to come to the school where the student is enrolled at. In order for LVDLCS School to run the programs waivers need to be signed. This is the plan as of now to be able to assist families with meals by USDA.
- **BB&T CD Matured** Close The CD account of \$250,000 was closed August 23rd because the percent in return was .0015%.
- **F & G Annuity** Open A recommendation from Fulton Bank is to invest in a \$250,000 CD for a 36 month period with an annual return of 2%
- Fulton CD Matured- Renew The \$250,000 CD with Fulton needs to be renewed at .005% because this account backs up the credit line the school has with them.

Mr. Lopez called for a motion to approve the closure of the BB&T Matured CD, the opening of an F & G Annuity and the renewal of the Fulton CD that matured as presented. Motion was seconded by Dr. Rance-Roney. Motion was approved unanimously.

• Community Service for Children- Service Coordination Agreement – The Auditors are requiring a memorandum of understanding between LVDLCS and Community Service for Children

Mr. Lopez called for a motion to approve a Memorandum of Understanding with Community Service for Children to as presented. Motion was seconded by Ms. Siderias. Motion was approved unanimously.
