Beginning in the 2016-2017 school year the entire LVDLCS community has been working diligently to complete the in-depth evaluation and review process. The Board of Trustees, staff, students, and parents all participated in the process by completing surveys, participating in interviews, and completing a self-evaluation that included all 12 of the Middle States Standards for Accreditation (mission, governance and leadership, school improvement planning, finances, facilities, school organization and staff, health and safety, educational program, assessment and evidence of student learning, student services, student life and activities, and information resources). The process culminated with an intense three day visit from a team of professionals from the Middle States Association.
