**Financial Report and Approval of Payments:** Mrs. Gutierrez guided the Board through the review of finances, LVDLCS's Balance Sheet at March 31st showed Cash (Checking Account + Investments) at \$2.5M, an increase of \$441K since the end of the prior year (06/30/2022), along with \$811K in School District Receivables. The school's Fund Balance (Assigned + Unrestricted + Net Income) at 03/31/23 has grown to \$2.6M, while Accounts Payable is \$143K and Accrued Payroll is \$462K. For the 9 months ending 03/31/2023, the school has an operating surplus of \$554K (projecting \$145K at year-end), and its financial health metrics remain strong: Current Ratio = 2.8 (Standard = 1.1), Debt Ratio = 62.9% (Standard = <85%), while Days COH is approaching the standard (57.5 Days, compared to a 60-Day Standard).

Mrs. Gutierrez called for a motion to approve the fiscal year financial report ending March 31, 2023 and for the list of bills to be paid. Motion was made by Mr. Lopez seconded by Ms. Weaver. Motion was passed unanimously.

#### Old Business

- Renovation Update The final layer of the paving should be done in the first 2 weeks of April.
- Administrative Area Construction The school is waiting to hear form the city of Bethlehem about the occupancy permit for the new space.
- Letter of Financial Interest Final collecting of forms

- Request of Financial Proposal (RFP) Information is being received from financial banks interested in bidding for the financing of the facility.
- Republic Services Correction to quote 3 companies were contacted for quotes. Waste Management quoted \$907 per month, Republic Services quoted \$520 per month, and Simmons Removal Services did not respond. Quotes are based on a 36 month agreement. The original contract service amount of \$520 was incorrect and it should be \$874.05. Price is still lower that Waste Management and the administration is still recommending to work with Republic Services.

Ms. Weaver called for a motion to approve the corrected contract price for Republic Services as presented. Motion was seconded by Mr. Lopez. Motion was approved unanimously

- Scholarship Fundraiser Update Total amount is at \$9,571.45 to date.
- Safety Grant Fund Reassignment The administration would like to reassign the funds from the lock system to a new Public Address system which is needed sooner. The lock system will still get done with grant money and the operations funds as needed.

Mr. Lopez called for a motion to approve the Reassignment of funds as presented. Motion was seconded by Ms. Parrales. Motion was approved unanimously.

• 2023-2028 Charter Renewal Update- Bethlehem Area School District (BASD), Dr. Silva and Ms. Peterson (attorney) conference with Ms. Herrmann to discuss the renewal of the charter. Dr. Silva and Ms. Peterson, both, shared positive things about LVDLCS and the programming the school delivers. The 2023-2028 Charter Renewal document presented by BASD was presented to the Board for approval. With this approval, BASD will be able to add our renewal to their May meeting for their approval and our official charter extension.

Mr. Lopez called for a motion to approve the 2023-2028 Charter Renewal document presented by BASD. Motion was seconded by Mr. Santana. Motion was approved unanimously.

**Financial Statements**

#### Members of the Board of Trustees Lehigh Valley Dual Language Charter School

This Summary and Management Report presents information we believe is important to you as members of the school board. We encourage you to review the sections of this report and we would be pleased to furnish additional information as requested. Monthly financials are intended to provide a snapshot of the financials as of a specific point in time. As a result, they are subject to variances due to timing – the most common example is when invoices are received after the financials are prepared.

#### **April Board Summary:**

LVDLCS's Balance Sheet at April 30<sup>th</sup> showed Cash (Checking Account + Investments) at \$3.1M, an increase of \$1M since the end of the prior year (06/30/2022), along with \$318K in School District Receivables. The school's Fund Balance (Assigned + Unrestricted + Net Income) at 04/30/23 has grown to \$2.9M, while Accounts Payable is \$13K and Accrued Payroll is \$556K. For the 10 months ending 04/30/2023, the school has an operating surplus of \$684K (projecting \$399K at year-end), and its financial health metrics remain strong: Current Ratio = 3.0 (Standard = 1.1), Debt Ratio = 61.8% (Standard = <85%), Days COH = 99.9 (Standard = 60 Days).

#### 1. Balance Sheet

- The school's combined Cash and Investment Balances were \$3,119,236 at April 30<sup>th</sup>, an increase of \$1,027,592 from the prior year-end (6/30/2022) due to several factors: receipt of federal grants (decrease of \$796K in receivables), increase in District (Tuition) Receivables (now \$318K) and a decrease in Current Liabilities (see next bullet).
- Total Current Liabilities on April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2023 represent a \$355K decrease since June 30<sup>th</sup> due to the payout of Accrued Salary to 10-month employees over the summer months, a \$187K reduction in Accounts Payable/Accrued Expenses and repayment of the school's Line of Credit (\$125K).
- The building purchase in August 2021 is reflected as a Fixed Asset (\$10M) and as a Liability (\$7.7M) on the Balance Sheet. Principal repayments are also shown on the Budget-to-Actual report in the Other Uses of Funds Debt Service section.

#### 2. Budget to Actual for the Ten (10) Months Ended April 30, 2023

- YTD Revenues from Local School Districts of \$5,178,570 are just over budget (+\$93K) as the total number of enrolled students is close to the budgeted target (450 Actual vs. 459 Budgeted).
- YTD Expenses of \$5,693,100 are below budget (by \$760K) through ten (10) months of activity due to variances in Personnel Costs (-\$462K), Supplies (-\$142K), Property Services (-\$167K) and Professional Services (-\$27K).
- The school shows a YTD Operating Surplus of \$684,482 at 04/30, a figure that mirrors the growth in Current Assets and reduction in Current Liabilities. We now project a year-end surplus of \$399,195.

#### 3. Financial Updates with Potential Impact on PA Charter School Community

• State of Black Learning Conference

The 2023 State of Black Learning (SBL) conference will be in Pittsburgh on August 9-11. We are pleased to announce that Charter Choices clients have access to discounted registration SBL this year.
