Kindergarten Supply List

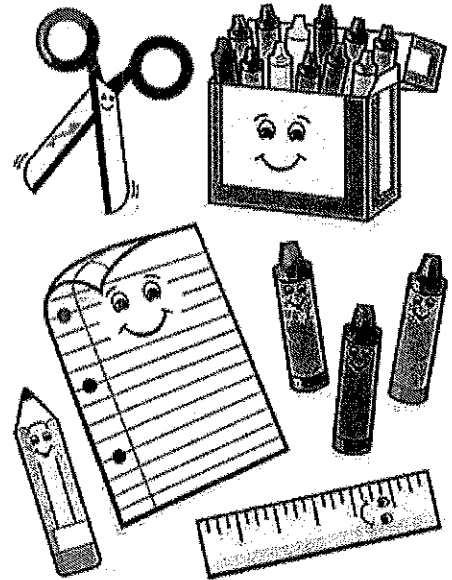
Personal Supplies:

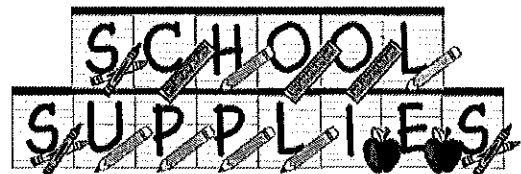

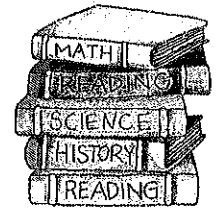
