The federal Every Student Succeeds Act of 2015 (ESSA) requires schools who receive Title I, Part A funds to notify parents or legal guardians when their child has been taught for four consecutive weeks by a teacher who has not met state certification/licensure requirements. 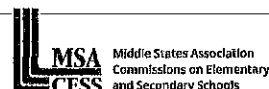

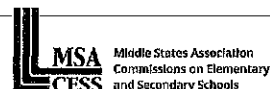
